If you are not completely satisfied with your Memoir grade, you have the opportunity to reflect on the changes to your essay you would make in order to advance in the categories on the rubric. However, this is not an easy task. This submission request must be completed thoughtfully and purposefully. Based on the quality of your revisions, you may earn a new grade on the rubric scale to mirror your revisions. Your goal is to show mastery (3.5 or 4) on these writing targets!

1. Identify the target(s) AND score(s) you want to improve. Put a ★ by the target you want to improve. ★ ↓

T1: I can summarize a text. I can explain how historical events, settings, or characters are represented in fictional texts. (P#1)	
T2: I can use details from the text to determine the theme or message of a story.	
T3: I can analyze how details from the text supports what the author states and what they imply and what I infer.	
T4: I can identify character/narrator in a text and compare their points of view.	
T5: I can explain how a character's actions can develop the plot and reveal more about the character.	
T6: I can identify how certain word choices influence the meaning and tone of a text.	
T7: I can write conclusions by reflecting on experiences and events I share in my stories.	
T8: I can use correct grammar, punctuation, capitalization...
