Pre- SAT words

1. **Debilitate-** to make something weaker, reduce strength, or limit usefulness.

EX: Tim's fear <u>debilitated</u> him from making a clear decision.

Coalesce- to come together to form a group, or mass
 EX: The hadrosaurs <u>coalesced</u> and stampede away from the

T-Rex.

3. **Lassitude-** the condition of being tired, lacking physical or emotional energy

EX: Dr. Grant was experiencing <u>lassitude</u> from being in the park with no food for 2 days.

4. **Resilient-** to be successful again after something has stopped you, or was bad, or deterred you.

EX: John Hammond continues to think J.P will be <u>resilient</u> after their accidents.

5. Prudent- having or showing careful judgement

EX: Dr. Grant is trying to make <u>prudent</u> choices to keep him and the kids alive.

6. Sullen- describing someone who is angry, unhappy, or gloomy.

EX: Ian Malcolm stared <u>sullenly</u> out the window.

7. Tirade- a long and (usually) angry/annoyed speech EX: John Hammond is fearful of a <u>tirade</u> from Ian Malcolm.

8. Unethical- something that is morally wrong, or bad, or against the 'greater good'.

EX: Some might say that recreating dinosaurs was <u>unethical</u> for humanity.

Latin Root Words- "bio" meaning life

9. Biopsy- the removal and examination of tissue, cells, or fluids from a living body

EX: Ellie Sattler took a biopsy from the Stegosaurus' mouth to examine.

10. Macrobiotic- an 'extra healthy' diet of grains and vegetables thought to help people live longer lives

11. Symbiosis-how two different living organisms live together and depend on each other.

EX: Compys live in <u>symbiosis</u> with the T-Rexes.

12. Neurobiology- the study of the nervous system of living things and how they learn and react

EX: Dr. Wu wants to be an expert in Dinosaur <u>neurobiology</u> to know about how dinos behave.

13. Biodegradable- something being able to be naturally broken down, reused into nature

EX: The deceased hadrosaur body will <u>biodegrade</u> into the soil and help fertilize it.

14. Biotathe animals, plants, fungi, etc., of a region or period.

EX: John Hammond attempted to recreate the <u>biota</u> of the Jurassic Period.

15. Biotechnology the manipulation of living things to produce useful products, e.g., crops resistant to disease, medicine

EX: Dr. Wu wants to use <u>biotechnology</u> to neutralize dilophosaurus spit.
