7th grade words

1. Neglect (verb) - to ignore, or to fail to take care of/give attention to something

ex: When you <u>neglect</u> to water your plants, they can die.

2. Persevere (verb) - to keep working at or persist at what you do through hard times

ex: She <u>persevered</u> during her run, even when it felt like she wouldn't reach the finish line.

3. Companion (noun) - a person to spend time with, a partner

ex: Leo was my studying <u>companion</u>, we helped each other for tests.

- 4. Abandon (verb) to give up completely or to desert
 - ex: We <u>abandoned</u> the house when we found mold in it.
- 5. Mourn (verb) to feel or express sadness
 - ex: Sally was mourning after her hamster had died.

Curriclum Words

6. Bias- a tendency to believe that some people, ideas, etc., are better than others

EX: He showed a *bias* toward a few workers

7. Cohesion (in writing)- a condition in which people or things are closely united and fit together

EX: A <u>cohesive</u> piece of writing is easy to read, and follow.

8. Thesis- a statement that someone wants to discuss or prove

EX: The author needed new evidence to support their *thesis*.

9. Generalization- the act or process of forming opinions that are based on a small amount of information

EX: Tabloids typically make <u>generalizations</u> about celebrity lives based on 1 photograph.

10. Expository Writing- writing that is used to explain, describe, give information or inform. Especially assuming that the reader has prior knowledge or prior understanding of the topic that is being discussed.

EX: I wrote about Hurricane Katrina for my <u>expository</u> essay.

Homophones

10. Patience (noun)- the ability to wait for a long time without becoming annoyed or upset

ex: "I am losing my <u>patience</u> waiting for you to finish working."

11. Patients (noun)- a person that receives medical care ex: Dr. Bran had a <u>patient</u> with the flu, and needed medicine. 12. Billed (noun)- being asked to pay for goods or services

ex: I get <u>billed</u> for my monthly magazine subscription.

13. Build (verb)- to make something by putting pieces together ex: IKEA makes you <u>build</u> your own table. 14. Roll (verb)- to move in a smooth, continuous way

ex: I watched the car <u>roll</u> to a stop at the red light.

15. Role (noun)- the part that someone plays in a relationship, or society.

ex: She had an important <u>role</u> designing the bridge.
